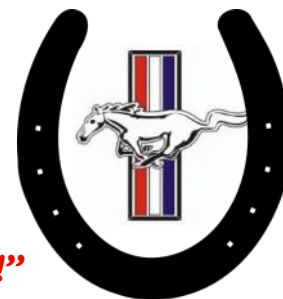

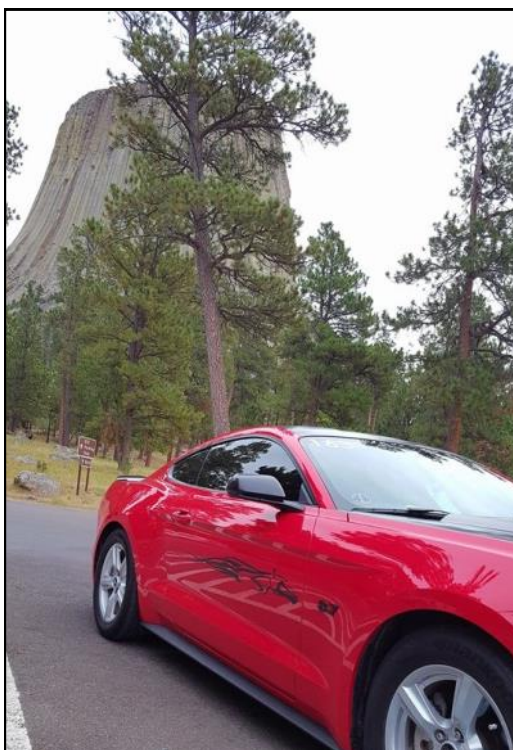

MESSAGE FROM THE EDITOR

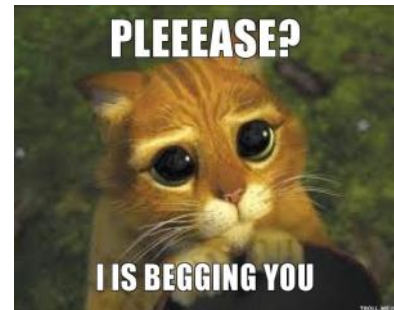

Northside Mustang Car Club - "Sister Club" to SAMC

Previously an announcement was made during our club meeting and through email to our members from Paul Woepfel (President of SAMC) about SAMC linking together with the Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) in the Houston, TX area. To learn more about NMCC and introduce them to our members, I reached out to Randy Weldon, President of NMCC. I asked if he would submit a story about NMCC as well as some photos of its members' cars. Below is what he sent! ~Becky Dowda

Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) was founded in June of 2009 and Chartered as a Regional Club by the Mustang Club of America creating 1 of 2 MCA Charter Clubs in the Houston, TX area.

Prior to being established, Mustang Owners had to travel over an hour to the west side of Houston to take part in organized Mustang Club activities as Members of the Mustang Club of Houston (MCOH). Today MCOH and NMCC work closely together to support each other and to deliver a larger positive impact for community outlook on the Mustang.

From inception, NMCC has been sponsored by Gullo Ford of Conroe/The Woodlands whose charity, Gullo Christmas for Kids, ensures children always have a Christmas and is supported by our club as is Honor Flight Houston which flies Veterans back to Washington DC to see War Memorials either for their 1st or potentially last time.

Each year NMCC holds 2 major car shows, one in the April/May timeframe (Gullo's All Ford Show to support Gullo Christmas for Kids) and one in October, the "Camaro vs Mustang Faceoff" to support Honor Flight Houston. (The HTown Camaro Club supports their charity during this event, The 100 Club for families of fallen 1st responders.)

NMCC also holds an annual Austin Overnight Cruise in June to grab a bite to eat overlooking Lake Travis and drive through the Hill Country, later relaxing and telling stories around the hotel pool.

Recently working in conjunction with the HTown Camaro Club we started what is believed will become an annual event, the "Camaro vs Mustang Bragging Rights Drag Racing Event."

NMCC also holds a monthly Cruise-In for Charity Event called TWCC, monthly dinners the 3rd Thursday of each month and a monthly Cruise-In for Fun event, the JCI Street Meet.

As NMCC has grown, we've focused on areas of club Members' passion and created "committees" for each area of passion. As an example, we created an Open Road Course Track Committee and now have members for an Open Course Track Team. The same is true for the Autocross (AutoX) Committee, Drag Racing Committee, Membership Committee, Car Show Committee, Family Events Committee, Cruise Committee and the OMR (Old Mustangs Rule) Committee who were originally called the OGR (Old Guys Rule) Committee until one of the guys objected to being called old....

Thru the creation of committees NMCC has become very active. On any given weekend it's now not unusual for NMCC to be taking part in 5 or more events in or around the city of Houston.

NMCC works very hard on 2 issues as a major focus: 1.) No Cliques; and 2.) No Drama. All of us got involved in our local club to have Fun. We're fortunate enough to have a Board of Directors who works well together and is very committed to working hard for the club. We're well aware that there is no club without our Members and our Members are here to have FUN.

Over the past year as the committee's have taken off, we've developed a slogan that we live, "Get Off the Couch with That Little Ol' Club from Texas, NMCC!"

We look forward to working closely to support SAMC and encourage any

SAMC Member finding themselves in the Houston area to come out & play with us.

By the way, there's a Mustang show too, to be held at the Sheraton Overland Park Convention Center adjacent to the host Sheraton Overland Park Hotel.

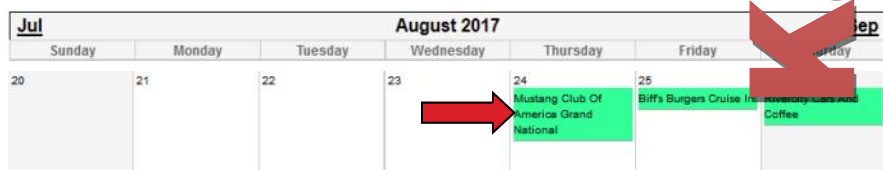
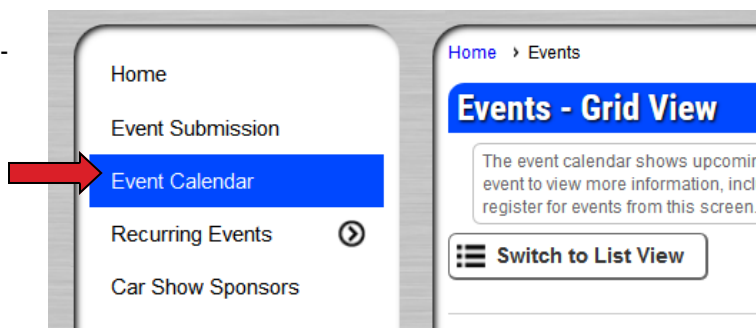
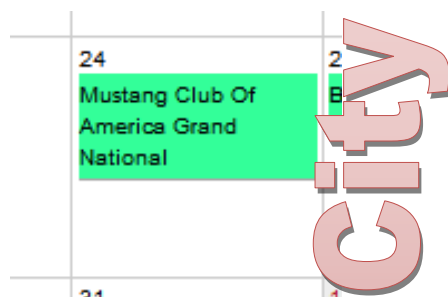

This is the time of the year when the MCA Nominating Committee accepts submissions for positions on the National Board of Directors of the Mustang Club of America. We are represented all around the world by different Mustang clubs and that number continues to grow. We are hereby seeking hard-working, dedicated men and women who want to become part of this great team by running for a position on the Board. You might ask, Why me? So I'll ask you, Why not? I asked the same question also and I'm glad I did. Don't be afraid to jump in and get your feet wet. It is so worthwhile. At the end of December 2017, several of our current directors terms will expire. It's time to submit your name and a short Bio for nomination to one of these positions.

You must be a current member in good standing of the MCA and 18 years of age before October 1, 2017, to serve on the Board of Directors. And look for another.

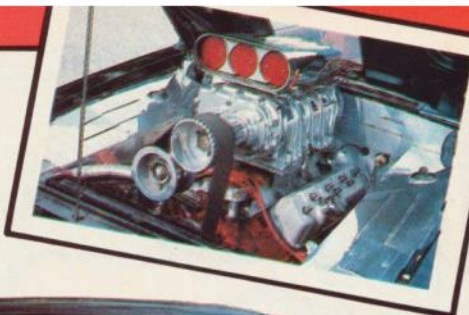

These two late-models from the land of Dixie run the gamut from mild to wild!

Traditionally known for its hospitality, genteel way of life, and antebellum architecture, the South is also home to a number of fine Mustangs. While early ponycars, particularly the 1965-66 models, still seem to command the lion's share of attention, there is a fast-growing contingent of enthusiasts who favor with the later, Fox-chassised versions.

We discovered many fine examples of such on our recent visit to the Gulf Coast Round-up in Pensacola, Florida. The two Mustangs on these pages represent the two extremes of what we saw being done in the late-model camp.

Vicki Bader, an insurance clerk from Montgomery, Alabama, owns the mildly modified '83 convertible that bears the appropriate license plate "SUN

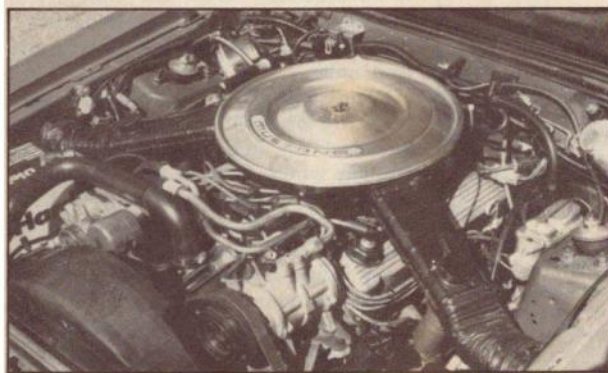
PONY." Vicki's husband Tom is a certifiable Mustang nut (with the emphasis on "certifiable") and has managed to slip the entire Bader household out of small economy cars and into his favorite mode of transportation. Now, Vicki and Tom (and sons Shawn and Larry) are active members of the Heart of Dixie Mustang Club and their modest driveway contains an '82 GT, the '83 SUN PONY, an '84 G.T. 350, and Tom's own modified '85 GT.

When Vicki received the '83 as an anniversary present a few years ago, it was nice looking but, owing to the fact that it was completely stock, it was nothing to write home about. The convertible took on a new, more exciting character once it was taken to Steve Johnson for painting.

Steve sprayed every inch of the car with factory Ford Red, including many of the parts that were originally black, then applied a body-length white pinstripe for definition. Sporting the monochromatic look, the stock TRX wheels didn't quite complete the picture, nor did a set of polished GT alloy rims. It wasn't until Tom found the



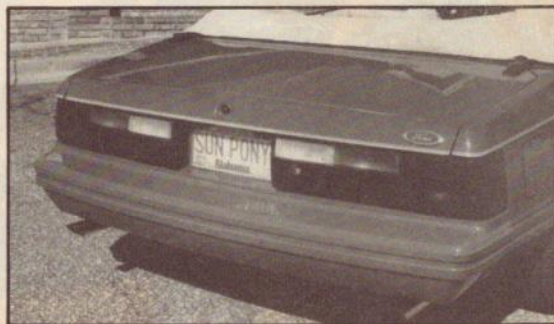

15x6.5 Sendel stars and equipped them with 225/60-15 Kelly radials that the transformation was considered a success.

Due to parts interchangeability between the various ponies in the family and Tom's obsession with "upgrading," Vicki's mostly stock 5.0-liter motor occasionally gets a few tweaks, like the '85 5.0 headers, off-road stainless steel exhaust system with H-pipe, re-

jetted carb, and Walker turbo mufflers. A 5-speed transmission and 3.08-geared rear axle complete the performance package.

Vicki's SUN PONY has been entered in ten shows as of this writing and has garnered nine first-place trophies.

Sitting squarely at the opposite end of the "mild to wild" spectrum is Randy Meek's radical '84 Pro-Street GT. Randy is an auto body man in Mil-

ton, Florida, so it is not surprising that the tech sheet for this blown street machine reads like a speed freak's shopping list.

Most obvious to passersby is the polished BDS 671 GM blower that rests on top of a Boss 302 aluminum intake manifold. Under that forced induction system is a red 1970 302 smallblock featuring a steel Boss 302 crankshaft, Boss 302 rods, TRW 12:1 pistons and rings, Motorsport camshaft, Boss 302 heads, Manley stainless steel valves, along with numerous custom-made and modified pieces. Spark comes from a Mallory dual-point distributor, coil, and wires. Exhaust is handled by aluminum-coated Kaufmann-built headers and twin turbo mufflers.

To take maximum advantage of the blown motor's torque curve, Randy installed an '85 T-5 5-speed with a 10.5-inch heavy duty clutch and a Lakewood bellhousing. A '72 Ford nine-inch rearend houses 5.14:1 Detroit Locker gears and Mark Williams-built custom axles.

Making room for the enormous rear tires required some serious frame modification (performed by Rodney Meek in Topeka, Kansas), which explains the carpet-covered steel wheel tubs that sit just under the rear hatch. The six-point rollcage is another clue that this is no ordinary street car. Comfort is not sacrificed, however, as the interior retains the stock red GT cloth seats and belts.

Randy did all of the bodywork and painting himself, including the relocation of the fuel filler to the rear of the car where it feeds into the home-made 22-gallon steel gas tank. Despite the hours of craftsmanship that went into the '84, Randy is not afraid to drive it and manages to rack up 5,000 miles or more a year.

So, the next time you're traveling below the Mason-Dixon line enjoying the sights and the food, just remember that the South has its share of fine Mustangs, too.

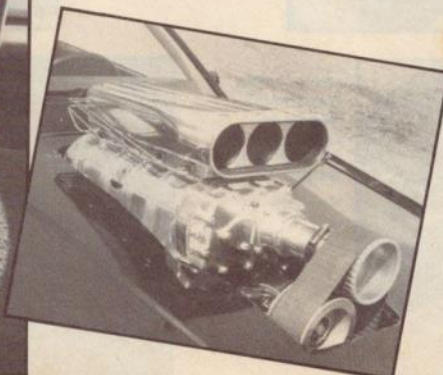

BELOW FAR RIGHT — The wheelie bars keep the front from getting too much air under heavy acceleration.

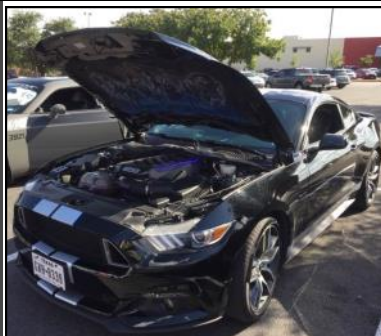


HEB-Plus Mini Show-n-Shine to promote the release of The Fate of the Furious (FAST 8) DVD

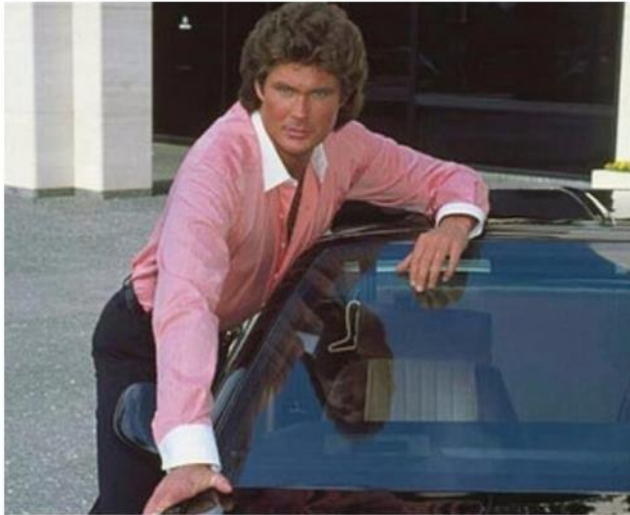
Grand Opening—Cibolo Creek Restorations

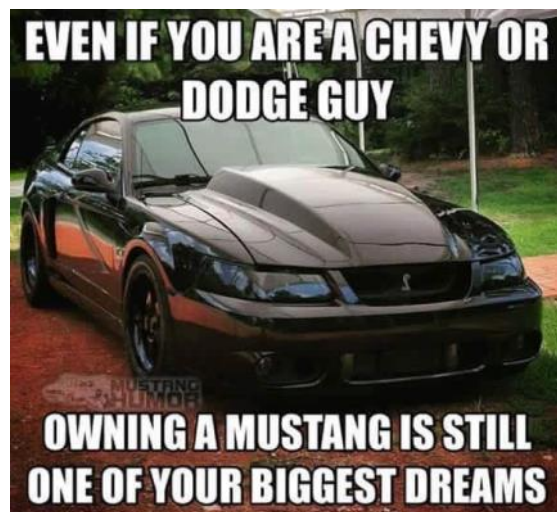

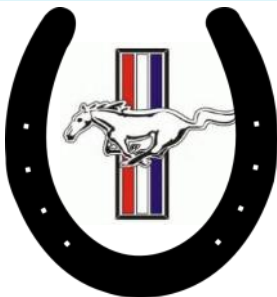
