#### Northside Mustang Car Club - "Sister Club" to SAMC

Previously an announcement was made during our club meeting and through email to our members from Paul Woeppel (President of SAMC) about SAMC linking together with the Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) in the Houston, TX area. To learn more about NMCC and introduce them to our members, I reached out to Randy Weldon, President of NMCC. I asked if he would submit a story about NMCC as well as some photos of its members' cars. Below is what he sent! ~Becky Dowda

Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) was founded in June of 2009 and Chartered as a Regional Club by the Mustang Club of America creating I of 2 MCA Charter Clubs in the Houston, TX area.

Prior to being established, Mustang Owners had to travel over an hour to the west side of Houston to take part in organized Mustang Club activities as Members of the Mustang Club of Houston (MCOH). Today MCOH and NMCC work closely together to support each other and to deliver a larger positive impact for community outlook on the Mustang.

From inception, NMCC has been sponsored by Gullo Ford of Conroe/ The Woodlands whose charity, Gullo Christmas for Kids, ensures children always have a Christmas and is supported by our club as is Honor Flight Houston which flies Veterans back to Washington DC to see War Memorials either for their 1<sup>st</sup> or potentially last time.

Each year NMCC holds 2 major car shows, one in the April/May timeframe (Gullo's All Ford Show to support Gullo Christmas for Kids) and one in October, the "Camaro vs Mustang Faceoff" to support Honor Flight Houston. (The HTown Camaro Club supports their charity during this event, The 100 Club for families of fallen 1st responders.)

NMCC also holds an annual Austin Overnight Cruise in June to grab a bite to eat overlooking Lake Travis and drive through the Hill Country, later relaxing and telling stories around the hotel pool.

Recently working in conjunction with the HTown Camaro Club we started what is believed will become an annual event, the "Camaro vs Mustang Bragging Rights Drag Racing Event." NMCC also holds a monthly Cruise-In for Charity Event called TWCC, monthly dinners the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month and a monthly Cruise-In for Fun event, the JCI Street Meet.

As NMCC has grown, we've focused on areas of club Members' passion and created "committees" for each area of passion. The same is true for the Autocross (AutoX) Committee, Drag Racing Committee, Membership Committee, Car Show Committee, Family Events Committee, Cruise Committee and the OMR (Old Mustangs Rule) Committee who were originally called the OGR (Old Guys Rule) Committee until one of the guys objected to being called old....

Thru the creation of committees NMCC has become very active. On any given weekend it's now not unusual for NMCC to be taking part in 5 or more events in or around the city of Houston.

NMCC works very hard on 2 issues as a major focus: 1.) No Cliques; and 2.) No Drama. All of us got involved in our local club to have Fun. We're fortunate enough to have a Board of Directors who works well together and is very committed to working hard for the club. We're well aware that there is no club without our Members and our Members are here to have FUN.

Over the past year as the committee's have taken off, we've developed a slogan that we live, "Get Off the Couch with That Little OI' Club from Texas, NMCC!"

We look forward to working closely to support SAMC and encourage any

SAMC Member finding themselves in the Houston area to come out & play with us.

#### **McClane Mustang Story**

It all started in 1971 when I saw the James Bond movie Diamonds Are Forever. After seeing that movie I had to have a Mustang Mach I

It was not until 1972 that I was able to order a brand new 1972 Mustang Mach I. I took delivery of the car on May 19, 1972, the very day I graduated high school. I traded a '67 Chevy Camaro and made payments of around \$82.00 a month! My first trip with my friends happened to be to a club to celebrate our graduation that night. Three of my friends and I pulled my Mach I into the gravel parking lot of the Red Rooster Club when my headlights caught the glowing argent stripes of what I thought was another Mach I. I parked beside that car and noticed that it did not have a urethane front bumper like mine. It was something that I had never seen before nor could have ever known how special that car was. What it turned out to be was a black and argent Boss 351 Mustang! I had no way of knowing at the time that this car was one of only 1806 Boss 351 cars made.

In 1973 I got married to a beautiful I7 year old girl and the Mach I became "ours" instead of "mine". All my life I had wanted to be a police officer so in 1975 I was accepted into the Houston Police Academy. I put a trailer hitch on the Mach I and pulled a UHaul to Houston from Sadler, Texas to begin a life in the city. We had a daughter later that same year and sold the Mach I in 1976 for a more practical family car. I missed my Mach I from the very day a young high school kid who I'd sold it to, drove away with it. I tried to buy the car back a couple of years later when I just happened to stop that exact Mustang for a traffic violation. No deal on the car and the same young man I'd sold it to, got off with a warning! Dang I wanted my Mustang back!!

Fast forward to 2013. I found myself in bed recovering from foot surgery looking at Mustangs on eBay. I knew one day I would find another Mach I and the Light Pewter 429CJ Mach I with a ton of options on eBay, caught my eye. I kept looking at the car and bidding, not meeting the reserve when my wife noticed. She told me to quit wasting my time bidding and just call them up and ask what the reserve is so they could just put me out of my misery. Well, I did call and ended up making a deal on the car I would have ordered in 1971, if I could have afforded all those options!

But, the story does not end here. Remember the very day I got my first Mach I and parked by that Boss 351? That was the first and only Boss 351 I had ever seen and at the time I had no idea what it was...... You guessed it, I was checking out Mustangs on eBay again and found a perfectly restored Medium Yellow Gold Boss 351 Mustang. This color was as close as you could get to my original Gold Glow '72 Mach I. I showed the pictures of the car to my wife (the same wife I started with in 1973 by the way) and she said that looks more like our old Mach I. .... Now, I have two of the most collectable 1971 Mustangs out there, sitting in my garage!

After acquiring the 429 Mustang I joined the Northside Mustang Car Club of Conroe, TX. I began to show my car and found I was making friends that did not carry a badge and gun like me. I had always seemed to focus on work and not have a lot of time for anything else. That car changed my life and made me realize that there is more to life than work. After 39 years with the police department I retired. I now enjoy showing and sharing both of my cars with others.

(On a side note.....Mike never misses a chance to rub in the fact to me that he doesn't have to worry about what time it is or what day....retirement.....enjoy it Mike! You are well deserving of it!!!)





We will need quite a few if we have as many cars as last year, so everyone must do their share in getting the prizes.

Let's go over what we have—place, time, date, trophies, door prizes. We must be ready for the show... WHOA!! What about workers? We will need people to register the cars, parkers, runners, judges, ticket sellers, vote counters, door prize workers, and after the show is complete, someone to help clean up and load up.

Well, we have covered some things required to have a car show. On the paperwork side, letters are sent out, ballots made, registration forms made, received, and kits put together—all of which takes people and time. To put on a show takes more than words "let's have a car show." Believe it or not, most people do it because they enjoy getting together and working toward a common goal. Having a successful show in terms of representation is always a bonus but when we are successful in earning money for a worthwhile cause, it makes all the hard work fun.


The club will rally up at 9:00am on the Northeast side of Loop 1604 & Hwy 281, in the HEB parking lot along the frontage road.

An interesting article in the December 1990 Newsletter of the Diablo Valley Mustang Association in Concord, California brought up a valuable observation about insuring your project cars. Many Mustang owner decide to drop their insurance coverage while their cars are not running.

Be careful! You might not want to drop all of your insurance. You might want to keep the comprehensive coverage just in case your garage burns down or a tree falls on the garage and damages the car. Some homeowners insurance policies—at least in California-do not cover automobiles on the premises.

You need to check with your insurance agent or read your policy to find out what kind of coverage your homeowners policy provides. Comprehensive coverage on an automobile policy is relatively cheapespecially considering the consequences.

The only two things that Jeremy and I had in common at that time were Mustangs and we are both veterans. Jeremy reached out and a solid friendship was made. I left that other group and have stayed with MSUS. Since then, I have made a plethora of friends, learned many tips and tricks about my car, and have attended a few events (to include feeding the homeless). My point is, there are many people who will come and go in your life. I have met people who are all talk and no action. Jeremy Matherly reached out to me when I was down and out. I felt like I didn't have a friend left in this world. My brother and I were very close. He was the first person to get me interested in Mustangs at the age of seven. My brother and I talked on the phone at least once a week and we sent text messages as well. In other words, Jeremy didn't ask or command respect and my friendship; instead, he reached out and showed me friendship. As a result, he not only has my respect and friendship but also the respect and admiration of the MSUS family.
