

Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) was founded in June of 2009 and Chartered as a Regional Club by the Mustang Club of America creating I of 2 MCA Charter Clubs in the Houston, TX area.

Prior to being established, Mustang Owners had to travel over an hour to the west side of Houston to take part in organized Mustang Club activities as Members of the Mustang Club of Houston (MCOH). Today MCOH and NMCC work closely together to support each other and to deliver a larger positive impact for community outlook on the Mustang.

New Scoring: OD, DD, and Specialty Classes

CA scoring for the Occasional Driven, Daily Driven, and Specialty classes has been an issue for many years. This all started back when we moved away from the days of cars competing directly against each other in their respective classes versus the new system of competing against a "standard of excellence" judging sheet, a system that has been in place for several years now. The former direct competition-style scoring potentially could have had a First-place car that was so far and away better than the balance of the cars in the class that there was only a First place awarded and no other awards earned in a class. The reason being was the balance of the class had to score within a few points of the named winner to be eligible for a

Second or Third place award. I won't go into great detail here since this is a mute point now that we have walked away from that system

We now use the "standard of excellence" style of scoring where there are a number of points available and a car must earn a certain percentage of those points to qualify for Gold, Silver, or Bronze. As it is now, there can be an infinite number of awards in each of the OD, DD, and Specialty classes. In other words, if each car scores high enough, every car can conceivably receive a Gold award.

Now I can discuss the issue we've had since the new system was put in place. For the Occasional Driven and Specialty class cars to earn a Gold award, they could miss just two points or less out of a possible 250 points total. Secondly, the Daily Driven cars could fall short only one point out of a possible 160 points to achieve a Gold award. Now, in my humble opinion, the scoring in these classes should be very tough since there is not an Authenticity component, but this scoring was too tight and we've heard about it from the owners and the judges of these classes. To achieve a Gold in these classes, a car had to score a higher percentage than a MCA Thoroughbred car! This is not to say that we've not had any of these cars achieve a Gold award. We have seen judging sheets come in from these classes with plenty of shortcomings written in the margins with little or no points deducted. To put it another way, the judges have become accustomed to the super-tight scoring requirements and adjusted their mindset to it. They are now reluctant to actually judge the car honestly since a very nice car will potentially go home without an award.



Now to the fix. Beginning with the fast approaching 2018 MCA show season, Assistant National Head Judges for OD/DD Billy Biggs and Jake Jarrell formulated a plan during the 2017 show season to change this system for the better. They did have help and input from several parties to put together a proposal for approval by the MCA Judging community and MCA Board of Directors. I'm happy to say that Head Judge Billy Henson presented that new scoring system to the MCA Board of Directors in October for the Occasional/Daily Driven and Specialty classes and it has been adopted for 2018.

Here are the basics: Occasional Driven and Specialty classes stay at 250 points available. Gold will be 97%: -0 to -8 points. Silver will be 94%: -9 to -15 points. And Bronze will be 91%: -16 to -23 points.

Daily Driven points will now be 200 points total (compared to 160 previously). Note that two points have been added to each of the 20 categories to reach the 200 total points. Gold will be 97%: -0 to -6 points. Silver will be 94%: -7 to -12 points. And Bronze will be 91%: -13 to -18 points.

Now before everyone gets giddy about how much "looser and easier" this new system looks, keep in mind that we will be instructing and advising our judging teams that they can now actually "take points" when they find deficiencies while judging a car in these classes. We as judges are looking to help you make your Mustangs better each time you bring them out. So clean and shine them, make those repairs, and get ready for next season. I think you will find this new system fair and equitable.




