



NT'S GETTING HOT! MELTING - SCORCHING - SIZZLING - BOILING - BURNING

Heat Exhaustion vs. Heat Stroke -Know the Signs & Symptoms



IS IT HEAT EXHAUSTION

Symptoms may include:

- Cool or moist skin with goose bumps when in the heat
- Heavy sweating
- Light headed or feeling faint
- Dizziness
- Fatigue
- Weak, rapid pulse
- Low blood pressure upon standing
- Muscle cramps
- Nausea
- Headache

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO...

- Notify someone you don't feel well
- Stop all activity and rest
- Move to a cooler place in shade or air conditioning
- Drink water or sports drink with electrolytes
- Lie down on ground and elevate feet
- OR You can sit in your car and put seat all the way back, put feet on dashboard



IS IT HEAT STROKE

Symptoms may include:

- Skin will feel hot and dry to the touch
- Body temp of 104F or higher
 - Flushed, red skin
 - Rapid, shallow breathing
- Racing heartbeat
- Headache
- Confusion or delirium
- Agitation and irritability
- Slurred speech
- Seizure or coma
- Nausea and vomiting

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO...


- Notfiy someone immediately that you're not feeling well
- Call 9-1-1
- Take action immediately to cool yourself while waiting for emergency treatment
- Get yourself indoor or into shade
- Remove excess clothing—hat, socks, shoes, gloves, etc
- Cool yourself down with whatever means possible—pour water over head, spray with garden hose, place ice packs on yourself or wet towels on the head, neck, armpits and groin
- Get into a cool tub of water or cold shower

<u>Please register on the SAMC website if you plan to attend</u> so we can make sure we have enough food.




We also still need volunteers to help serve the food and cook. So if you would like to help in any capacity, please let me [Paul Woeppel] know.

A Calendar of their planned events will follow on the next page. Everyone is welcome to participate in their activities, and SAMC will make every effort to list them on our Calendar as well.

Northside Mustang Car Club (NMCC) was founded in June of 2009 and Chartered as a Regional Club by the Mustang Club of America creating 1 of 2 MCA Charter Clubs in the Houston, TX area.

Prior to being established, Mustang Owners had to travel over an hour to the west side of Houston to take part in organized Mustang Club activities as Members of the Mustang Club of Houston (MCOH). Today MCOH and NMCC work closely together to support each other and to deliver a larger positive impact for community outlook on the Mustang.

From inception, NMCC has been sponsored by Gullo Ford of Conroe/ The Woodlands whose charity, Gullo Christmas for Kids, ensures children always have a Christmas and is supported by our club as is Honor Flight Houston which flies Veterans back to Washington DC to see War Memorials either for their 1st or potentially last time.




